**Regular Meeting**

**Members Present:** Supervisor Robert Corrin, Clerk Sue Emmendorfer, Treasurer Cathy Gross; Trustees: Kevin Carlton, William Hedrich, Peter Hemgesberg, and Ken Hornak.

**Public Comments:** none.

**Committee/Board Reports:**

Cemetery – Hemgesberg reported cemetery fencing is in place along the riverbank stabilization cliff; some cemetery roads are eroding.

Parks & Rec – Carlton reported participation in the annual Candle Walk with 600 cookies given away; and the monthly meeting will be next week.

Rehmann Health Center – Gross reported the United Appeal will be sending out reminder notices next week.

Fire Board – Corrin reported receipt of the completed Saginaw County Mutual Aide; received a used generator from the rest home; the Michigan Blood Bank will be utilizing the fire barn for community blood draws; new chairs were bought with the pancake breakfast proceeds.

MMWA – Emmendorfer noted the annual meeting will be 11 a.m. December 12 at the Swan Valley Banquet Center; also noted the executive board will be reappointed at that time.

Task Force – Carlton noted the DDA provided carriage rides during Candle Walk and provided \$10,000 for the footbridge project; no meeting in December, but two are scheduled for January 10 and 24, 2012.

Supervisor – Corrin noted state Sen. Roger Kahn or his representative will be at the village office 1 to 2 p.m. December 2; Santa's Village will continue each weekend for the next three weeks at the Saginaw County Fair Grounds; the November Supervisor's meeting saw more discussion of elimination of personal property taxes and the marijuana law; County Road Rep. Rob Hudec visited the township last week to discuss road issues.

Clerk – Emmendorfer reported February 28, 2012 Presidential Primary; noted 667 hits to the township's website last month with 61 percent taking place during non-office hours, at [www.chesaningtp.org](http://www.chesaningtp.org).

Treasurer – Gross reported Winter Tax Bills were mailed with a couple already returned for payment; Summer Tax Bills are still coming in with 4 percent added through December; she attended a SALTA meeting that honored County Treasurer Marv Hare who is stepping down; also noted the Board of Review will meet 6 p.m. Dec 12, 2011.
