<u>Opening Comments:</u> Corrin noted the purpose of the joint meeting is to discuss settlement prospects regarding the annexation dispute between the Township of Chesaning and the Village of Chesaning.

Village Manager Feltman gave a history of the situation noting Beau Parmenter approached the Village regarding annexation of his township property into the village; the Village Council approved the annexation and it was forwarded on to the County for consideration. He added a presentation of the intent for the property will be given during the meeting.

Attorney Patrick Greenfelder, representative for Beau Parmenter commented on the recent Saginaw County Service Committee meeting held in January regarding the annexation, in summary, he noted tonight's meeting is to try to resolve objections presented at the County Service Committee meeting.

James Foulds, of The Plant Life Group gave a presentation on the proposed medical marihuana use of the property and proposed business plan.

<u>Public Comments:</u> The floor was open to public comment. Many comments pro and con on medical marihuana and few comments on annexation were heard.

**<u>Business:</u>** Intense discussion between members of the boards, the owner and partners of the property, and members of the general public took place with no resolution. It was noted the issue will move on to the County Board of Commissioners Service Committee in a meeting to be held on March 7, 2018.
